At our January 3rd District Board Meeting our District Superintendent, Dr. Mark Eckart, presented a program to eliminate the debt our district took on as a result of buying the 118 acres of farm land which joins the campground on the west side.

The program is called G.L.A.D. which stands for "Gideon's Leaders Against Debt." If 300 people or churches would agree to pay \$1200.00 over a period of 4 years the debt will be eliminated.

When this program was presented to the D.B.A. there were fifteen units spoken for at that meeting with Rev. England and Dr. Eckart taking two each. It

would be great if every church in Indiana South District would at least take one unit. Some could take more.
