Rev. Glenn D. Black—Instructor



Rev. Glenn D. Black was ordained as a minister in The Wesleyan Church on July 22, 1974. He has pastored Wesleyan churches in Ohio and Indiana. He served as editor of *God's Revivalist* and as District Superintendent of the Kentucky District of The Wesleyan Church. He served as a member of the Board of Trustees at SWU and IWU and is presently on the Board of Trustees at KMBC. He has a Bachelor of Religious Education degree from God's Bible School and a Master of Arts degree from Indiana Wesleyan University..

In the Indiana South District, he has served as Asst. District Superintendent, editor of *Indiana South Wesleyan*, Family Camp Coordinator and has served on various committees and boards.

Rev. Daniel Speas—Instructor






